#### Re: American Legion Auxiliary Scholarships

It is the 'mission' of the American Legion Auxiliary to advocate for and support our military veterans, current military members, and their children and grandchildren. Part of that mission is to educate our children. In that light, I am writing today to tell you about scholarships sponsored by the American Legion and American Legion Auxiliary. Please encourage your students to learn more about these scholarships and how to apply for them. Each of the scholarships has a unique deadline and criteria and can be accessed online. They are also available by contacting the Unit President or other officer of the local **American Legion Auxiliary** in your community. The following scholarships are available.

SAMSUNG American Legion Scholarship- To show its appreciation for U.S. veterans who came to Korea's aid during its struggle against communist forces during the Korean War, worldwide electronics leader Samsung, established a scholarship fund of \$5 million in 1966. The American Legion administers the Samsung American Legion Scholarship Program, which is funded by the interest and other income from the endowment. Twenty youth nationwide receive this scholarship each year. Students who are finishing their junior year in high school and attend the American Legion's North Dakota Boys State or American Legion Auxiliary's Girls State programs in June 2023 are eligible for the Samsung scholarship.

The American Legion Auxiliary, Department of North Dakota, Past Presidents Parley awards three scholarships each year. These scholarships may be used at a nursing school of the student's choice. Applicants must be a graduate of a North Dakota High school or if from out-of-state they must be a member of the American Legion Family.

- Past Presidents Parley Nursing Scholarship (2) \$500 scholarships are awarded annually
- Past Presidents Parley Grace Holmes, MD Nursing Scholarship (1) \$1000 scholarship is awarded annually

American Legion Auxiliary Department of North Dakota - Education Program - The American Legion Auxiliary, Department of North Dakota, through its Education Program sponsors a program to assist students pursuing a degree in the field of their choice.

- Scholarships of \$500.00 are awarded to eligible students attending a college, university, or trade school in North Dakota.
- Membership and/or affiliation with the American Legion and American Legion Auxiliary is not required for scholarship selection.
- Applications are available online at <u>www.ndala.org</u> or by contacting the Auxiliary's Department Office at secretary@ndala.org.

American Legion Auxiliary National Level Scholarships - The American Legion Auxiliary sponsors one \$2,500 scholarship, two \$5000 scholarships and one \$2000 scholarship on the National level. Scholarships are awarded annually in each of the five divisions of the American Legion Auxiliary. The eligibility criteria and rules as well as the applications can be found on the American Legion Auxiliary National Headquarters website at: <a href="https://www.alaforveterans.org">www.alaforveterans.org</a>.

- Children of Warriors National Presidents Scholarship (\$5,000) fifteen scholarships awarded nationwide, three in each of the five divisions. This scholarship is a gift, not a loan. Application for the Children of Warriors scholarship is available online only. Visit the American Legion Auxiliary National website at <a href="https://www.alaforveterans.org">www.alaforveterans.org</a>.
- Spirit of Youth Scholarship for Junior Members (\$5,000) fifteen scholarships awarded nationwide, three in each of the five divisions. This scholarship is a gift, not a loan.
- Junior Member Loyalty Scholarship (\$2,500) Ten scholarships awarded nationwide, two in each of the five divisions. This scholarship is a grant, not a loan.
- Scholarship for Non-Traditional Students (\$2,000) five scholarships awarded, one in each of the five divisions. This scholarship is a gift, not a loan.

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### PAST PRESIDENTS PARLEY NURSING SCHOLARSHIP Instructions for the 2022-2023 School Year

The American Legion Auxiliary, Department of North Dakota, Past Presidents Parley, has scholarships to assist students pursuing a degree in the nursing field. The scholarship applications are available from the Department of North Dakota Headquarters by email at: <a href="mailto:secretary@ndala.org">secretary@ndala.org</a> or the Auxiliary website: <a href="mailto:swww.ndala.org">www.ndala.org</a>.

- 1. Applicant eligibility:
  - Must be a graduate of a North Dakota high school or home school and must be a child, grandchild, great-grandchild (adopted, step), of an active-duty military or an honorably discharged veteran who is living or deceased.
  - If a graduate of an out-of-state high school, applicant must be a member of the North Dakota American Legion Family (American Legion, American Legion Auxiliary, Sons of the Legion).
  - The applicant may be an honorably discharged veteran or the spouse of a veteran.
- 2. If the applicant's veteran eligibility/affiliation is with the American Legion Family, no military-issued document is required.
- 3. If the applicant's veteran eligibility/affiliation is not with the American Legion Family, a *photocopy* of the veteran's <u>Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (Form DD-214)</u> or other government-issued document showing time served as active-duty military must accompany the application.
- 4. Accompanying the application (*for high school applicant*) please include one letter of recommendation from:
  - a. A school administrator, principal, counselor, teacher, advisor, or similar position.
- 5. Accompanying the application (for a veteran or spouse of a veteran), please include one letter of recommendation from a person of your choice.
- 6. An approximate 200-word essay written by the applicant describing his or her background, education and ambition for the nursing profession must be included with the application.
- The scholarship may be used at a nursing school of the student's choice. Proof of acceptance must be included with the application.
- 8. The applicant must sign and date the application.
- 9. The completed application, 200-word essay, one letter of recommendation, proof of nursing school acceptance (if applicable) and veteran's affiliation, if necessary, (refer to #3) must be returned by April 1, 2023. 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#### PAST PRESIDENTS PARLEY NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

The American Legion Auxiliary Past Presidents Parley Nursing Scholarship will be awarded to worthy applicants pursuing RN or LPN training. The scholarship amount is \$500. Scholarship funds will be paid by March 1, 2024, to the school of choice after the applicant can verify enrollment and satisfactory academic progress. Basis of Judging: Need 50%, Scholarship 30% and Character 20%.
